Each team is led by a Team Leader and the Group is led by two senior personnel acting as Group Leaders. Filemaker maintains project work flow through time sheet entry and project completion updates on a daily basis. This allows Project Managers to interrogate project expenditure and time lines on demand.

Ecoscope implements a comprehensive set of quality control measures across all aspects of the Company's operation and has maintained Quality Assurance ISO 9001 certification since 2007. Ecoscope's certification covers the Quality Management System for the provision of consulting services. An internal quality review process is applied to all project tasks. Each document is carefully reviewed by senior members of the consultancy team and signed off prior to issue. Draft documents are submitted to clients for comment and acceptance prior to final production.
